CHURCH NURSERY

Nursery care for infants and toddlers is available every Sunday during Sunday Forum and worship. Our church nursery is staffed by a paid childcare provider to provide a loving, familiar face for the children each Sunday.

CHILDREN'S CHURCH SCHOOL

11:15 a.m. Sundays

(except the first Sunday each month)

September – May

Classes are offered for preschool and kindergarten ages, Grades 1-2, and Grades 3-5. Families attend the beginning of worship together, and children are invited upstairs to class following the Time with Children.

We offer a church school community where everyone is welcomed. A volunteer teaching staff of caring and dedicated teachers provides a variety of creative learning experiences.

Activities complementing our church school program are also provided for older children during Sunday Forum so that parents may attend Forum.

CHILDREN'S MUSIC

September – May

Children in preschool through fifth grade gather on selected dates in the Chapel for music from 11:55 a.m.-12:15 p.m. (schedules go home with children and will be in the bulletin calendar). Led by Director of Music Ministry, Lee Wright, children discover divine presence in their own creative play with voice and musical instruments. They sing regularly to lead the congregation in worship, learn music fundamentals using a Christ-centered approach, play with music related to their church school lessons, and play instruments to complement their vocal praise.

YOUTH GROUPS

9:50 a.m. Sundays

September – May

Middle School and Senior High groups meet on Sunday mornings for fellowship, explorations of the Bible and topics relevant to their lives, and service projects. Youth attend worship together the first Sunday of each month.

Fellowship events are also offered periodically at other times during the week.

FOR THE FUN OF IT

Each month a fun activity is planned for families, friends, and other members of the congregation to gather for fun and fellowship.

CHILDREN & WORSHIP

The first Sunday of each month is communion Sunday, and children and youth remain in worship with their family and friends. Worship is designed with their presence in mind, and they assist during the worship service with greeting, ushering, lighting candles, and serving communion.
